## What are Transition Services?

Information and planning is needed to prepare students with disabilities to move from school to life after high school. The student and the student's family/guardian can take an active role in deciding on future planning that will best meet the student's needs, preferences, and interests.

This may include: post secondary education, vocational education, integrated employment, continuing and adult education, adult services, independent living, or community participation.

## How Can a Resource Specialist Help You?

- Information on adult programs and services.
- Information on choices, rights, and responsibilities.
- Information on guardianship, power of attorney for health care and finances, representative payee, and supported decision making.
- Assistance and advocacy to determine eligibility for private and public programs.
- Information and understanding of Social Security and Medicaid.
- Information on vocational services and employment programs.
