Medicare Savings Programs

Medicare Savings Programs could pay your Medicare Part B premium, a potential savings of over \$1,782 per year. **You may qualify for Medicare Savings Programs if:**

YOU'RE SINGLE AND

- Your assets are under \$7,970
- And your gross monthly income is under \$1,449

YOU'RE MARRIED AND

- Your assets are under \$11,960
- And your gross monthly income is under \$1,959.75

Prescription Extra Help

The Prescription Extra Help program could help pay for your prescribed medications and protect you from the coverage gap. You may qualify for the Prescription Extra Help program if:

YOU'RE SINGLE AND

- Your assets are under \$14,790
- And your gross monthly income is under \$1,610

YOU'RE MARRIED AND

- Your assets are under \$29,520
- And your gross monthly income is under \$2,177.50

SeniorCare

SeniorCare is a prescription drug assistance program. SeniorCare is considered creditable coverage and can be used to fill the coverage gap under Medicare Part D. To enroll in SeniorCare:

- You must be a Wisconsin resident.
- You must be a U.S. citizen or qualifying immigrant.
- You must be 65 years of age or older.
- You must pay a \$30 annual enrollment fee per person.
- Your assets, such as bank accounts, insurance policies, home, property, etc., are not counted.
- Your annual income determines the level of coverage (and your amount of out of pocket expense)
